- 1) Apologies none. Eric Leach was present to meeting and left shortly afterwards. The meeting agreed to limit itself to discussing the current situation under 5 headings. Later meetings might discuss wish-lists, problems and developments in the future.

- 2) **What is the situation for walking?**
Congested pavements 4 sites noted, 3 associated with bus-stops
Permeability of GMLE
Jacob's Ladder security and not step-free.
Dean Gardens security and night-time problems
Discussion about routes through Sherwood Close
Discussion about lighting and after dark walking
Improved pedestrian crossing to Lido Junction thanks to MT and AB
EPTUG
WEN and others

- 3) **What is the situation for cycling?**
Cycle routes shown as signposts but not properly engineered. Example is E-W route parallel route to Uxbridge Road Grosvenor Rd to Ealing Common
Jacob's Ladder not suitable for cycles
Poor route N-S through Lido junction
Cycle racks sufficient. At station?
Uxbridge Road heavily used by cyclists often surfaces badly maintained

- 4) **What is the situation for buses?**
No current N-S route through Lido junction
No bus routes from station to centre (Sainsbury's)
Buses and station not integrated
Bus stop rationale two stops 100m apart for different bus Nos but with buses going in the same direction. (historical?)

- 5) **What is the situation for trains?**
Situation will change Crossrail plan for station to be at Manor Road.

- 6) **What is the situation for cars?**
At present indications are that there is enough parking not to restrict shoppers.
GMLE using clampers (£130) no one will say who made decision
Need to produce map of current spaces and CPZ rules.
Car parking for shoppers has been lost in GMLE dev
Multi-storey car park has been lost next to mosque.
Council have provided for first time commuter parking in Manor Road.
CPZ to south and north will continue to spread
